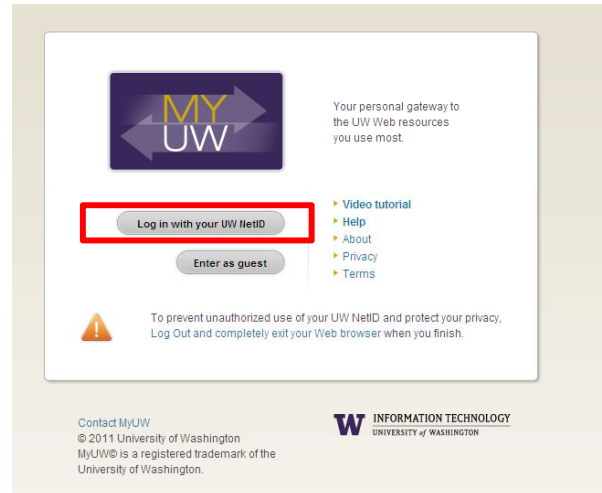


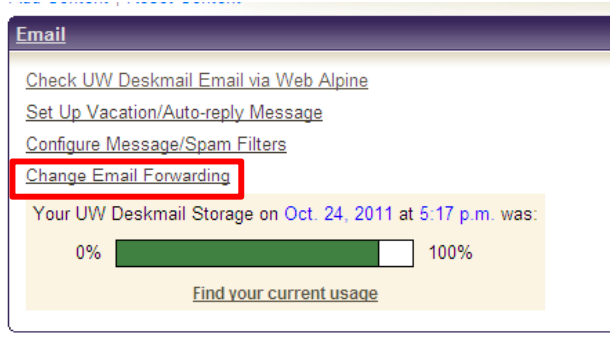
# How to Stop Forwarding Your @uw.edu account

1) Go to <http://myuw.washington.edu/>

2) Sign in using your UWNetID



3) Go to the Email section  
- Select "Change Email Forwarding"



3) Select "Forward to UW Deskmail" (this is essentially forwarding it to itself) and click OK

- Email is inherently insecure. Sending sensitive information (like patient or student data) by email is unsafe, especially if you forward the UW Email for UW NetID 'cotting' off-campus to a non-UW ISP.
- Forwarding the UW Email for UW NetID 'cotting' to a non-UW email address is not recommended because forwarded email may not reach its destination due to anti-spam and anti-virus efforts by ISPs.
- If you stop the UW Email for UW NetID 'cotting' or change the forwarding to a different email address, you cannot set up a vacation/auto-reply message or filter the incoming email using the Email Delivery Manager system.
