  - Immittance audiometry, including tympanometry, acoustic reflex thresholds, and decay, and Eustachian tube function tests.
  - Auditory Brainstem Response testing for failed universal newborn screenings, suspected retro-cochlear etiologies, suspected malingerers— including test interpretation.
  - Distortion product otoacoustic emissions testing and interpretation.
  - Canalith repositioning procedures including Semont, Epley, and Barrel-roll maneuvers as needed.
