

## Criteria for Appointments and Promotion of Clinical Faculty

### Department of Pathology

#### CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR

- Completion of formal training to meet board requirements or equivalent
- Contribution to Department program in teaching, research or service

#### CLINICAL ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

- Training and experience substantially beyond that for Clinical Instructor
- Contribution to medical education, the medical profession, or standing of the profession in the community in significant manner

#### CLINICAL ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

- Outstanding contribution in teaching and care of patients in Schools' program
- Scholarly contribution to literature (scientific papers, books, teaching, manuals, etc.) highly desirable but not required
- Appointment may also be based on distinguished activity in community service and leadership role in professional societies

#### CLINICAL PROFESSOR

- National recognition as in field as evidenced by original scientific publications (scientific papers, books, teaching, manuals, etc.)
- Appointment as an officer/member of the board of national or international medical and professional societies
- Appointment may also be based on distinguished professional activity in teaching in patient care and professional service to community and/or region over a long period of time, and dedication to the programs of the Department and School
